If we look from the individual perspective, 21st century man is a busy animal, engulfed in the cobwebs of complexities and competition. He has no time to spare for himself, otherwise he would be left out of the never ending race. And while coping with the stressful situations, very often health comes as the last priority for him. And because of this, he pays the least attention to ~~his~~ health, only when he falls ill which has a debilitating effect on his life, he understands the importance of being healthy and regrets. taking steps to come out of the damage done and undergoes rehabilitation. Thereby it's true that often health is not valued until sickness comes.

This phenomenon is often observed at almost every sphere of life. If we dwell into the history of the world, a healthy world usually would be pictured as a peaceful place with everyone coexisting with mutual respect for each other. But often the importance of such a world is not understood by many. During the World War 2, many countries like England didn't pay much heed to Germany growing as a powerful state and the war began with the main motto behind it - the colonial interests. The war dragged on and the healthy

peaceful coexistence of people was being undermined, until the final blow of the nuclear bomb at Japan happened, the importance of a peaceful world came into the forefront.

Even at the present context too, the same proposition exists. Looking at the Syria issue, the healthy undercurrents here would be sovereignty of the nation state, democracy and people's rights. But all

 world. Therefore here also the
 health as in sovereignty was not
 paid respect to with ruthless
 interference by others such as US,
 Saudi Arabia and others; until the
worst sickness in the form of ISIS
came up.

Now if we come to the Indian

scenario, there is not much change to be seen. In the social sphere, the caste system is the best example. When the Varna system was brought in, it came up to bring in a systematic and proper way of living in the society. At that time, people had the freedom to work as they desired into the 4 varnas ~~but~~ and the society was having an healthy environment of freedom and equality. But slowly the whole setting got skewed. There started a dominance of the upper two varnas and now caste became an ascribed feature rather than depending on capabilities. Soon it turned ugly with growing discrimination and oppression by a large population who

belonged to the so called lower castes. Only this sickness of gross violation of human rights led to the realisation of the importance of the pristine nature of the varna system with freedom and equality as basic epithets of human living. To undo these wrongdoings, independent India came up with reservation systems but alas, only after the sickness of discrimination had done much damage.

Similarly in the political sphere, when India got her independence she was blessed with a very strong leadership in the political system with the names such as Jawaharlal Nehru, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel,

Dr. Rajendra Prasad and many more. They all contributed towards a very dedicated, clean and efficient government. And because of them people of India had great faith in the government and the political system. But with time, deterioration crept in in the form of tendency of centralising powers as witnessed during Emergency, increasing criminalisation of politics, rampant cases of corruption. All these sicknesses proved to be a big blow at the trust of the people and credibility of the government. Here again the value of a healthy government and political system as being a clean and efficient one, was only felt when the sicknesses as said above showed up. To rectify

these, now the thrust is on a transparent and accountable govt: with RTI, social audit, citizens charter, and other initiatives coming up.

Similarly in the environmental scenario, often the focus towards development undermines its importance. The Industrial revolution, no doubt ushered in a new era of growth and development, but its ill-effects on the environment were galore. But the importance of a healthy environment but not given much attention, until the sickness in the form of global-warming started showing its detrimental effects. To counter it, now countries are coming up with India also contributing in the form of INDCs.

In the Indian context, Chandragupta Maurya and Kautilya depict the proposition. Taking advantage of the growing discontent amongst the people against the incumbent ruler, they together used this opportunity to depose him and established the great Mauryan empire of India. Thereby again, climbing the ladders of opportunity at the right time, ensured success for them.

Now if we look at the Indian social scenario, the British colonial rule no doubt inflicted several injuries to India but in the garb

of this problem, there also existed a flicker of opportunity, with the thrust from Indian reformers such as Raja Ram Mohan Roy, Iskwar Chandra Vidyasagar, and others; the Britishers brought about various laws banning sati, against child marriage, promoting girl education. Since our reformers made best use of this opportunity, thereby Independent India was somewhat in a better position than its previous state.

Also another vivid eg. is Haryana becoming the hub of sports in India. This has been possible because of the support from the Haryana Govt. to the sportsman in form of infrastructure, monetary support, etc.

Over time these players got such an opportunity to enhance their skills, thereby sports persons from Haryana hold the record of most of the medals in international competitions.

Now, coming to the political scenario, if India wouldn't have trusted the maturity of its people at the time of the 1st elections in 1950 and not implemented adult franchise, then maybe India wouldn't have become the largest democracy in the present world. Grabbing that right opportunity at the right time, helped India in achieving this. Similarly, in the strong focus of patriarchal mindset and certain social inequalities existing

even in present Indian society, their equivalent representation in the political system wouldn't have been possible if not provided with the opportunities of reservation for women and SCs and STs in the political scenario - in panchayats as well as Parliament. Utilising this opportunity only, they are being empowered to say ~~their~~ say in the political undertakings of the govt. and rise in the ladder towards their emancipation.

~~In the economic sphere,~~ the BOP crisis was an eye opener for India and heralded various positive developments as ~~in~~ embracing LPG reforms and progressive reforms of

delicensing and deregulation in the economy, which finally integrated India with the global economy. This resulted in increased FDI flows and investments from abroad which helped India to remain the 'Bright spot' today in the turbulent global ~~the~~ economy scenario. Thereby, again, success was achieved by grabbing the opportunities at right time.

Similarly in technological aspects there is no best eg. than ISRO. During the Pokhran nuclear experiments in 1998, sanctions were imposed on India and Russia couldn't provide the cryogenic technology for space.
