It is true that health is not valued till sickness comes since sickness means the realisation of inability to be unproductive. ~~The~~ treatment

A healthy life encompasses a successful life which is devoid of pain and suffering. But a good health is a never ending process requiring a constant struggle and productive capacity to create a proper balance between all components of the ecosystem that we live in.

only 'necessity' led business does not explain why people don't care till they fall sick.

Remarks

we should start from "basic" and later extend it to society, ignoring health may result from lack of economy, knowledge, money, access to hospitals, policy, sedentary life, new food culture, lack of climate, balanced diet and nutrition etc.

India has never seen the necessity to open its economy to global market. It was only during 1991 when it suffered from heavy balance of payment crisis with majority of its enterprises sick and unproductive that it chosen the path of sound and healthy economic policy: the LPG reforms (Liberalisation, ~~on~~ privatisation and Globalisation). The entry of private firms not only improved competitive market but made several PSUs like BSNL, ONGC, OIL etc healthy and at par with global MNCs.

It was only after the world war 1 and devastation at global level during world war 2 when peace and prosperity destroyed, and world seemed to be at inevitable collapse that United Nations organisation was formed in 1940s to promote world peace (mental and psychological health).

India never encouraged defense expenditure and enthusiastically promoted NAM (non-aligned Movement) but the Indo-China war of 1962.

Remarks

revealed India's sickness regarding its defence and national security which further provoked Pakistan to attack and victimise India.

It was in backdrop of these incidences that India ~~became~~ produced a healthy defence and security system. Presently India being the 4th largest defence power and dictating security issues regarding terrorism and other challenges at global level.

A healthy life activates participation in multi-dimensional activities.

Causes for not valuing health before sickness:

We fail to appreciate the value of good health because of several factors. First is the lack of appropriate resources. People in Kathmandu (Nepal) know the proneness to earthquake but lack proper resource to create infrastructure to mitigate the consequences.

Bihar, in lack of resources is prone to flood (sickness) but in lack of proper technology to scientifically manage it renders it vulnerable.

Similarly, the lack of foresightedness and status quoist behavior of people make them accept

the consequence and then mend their way of living to prevent future devastation.

" people usually learn to respect fire when they themselves get a burn."

Some time lack of innovation skill and cultural practices of avoiding preparedness make them value good health until they fall devastation.

A student learn the value of hard work when he fails in the exam.

Valuation of good health before sickness:

But it is not always that people value good health until sickness comes.

There are people who work hard (a measure of good health academic health) without actually facing failures in life.

It is short vision speculation and foresightening that makes a person to appreciate the consequence of good health before he face actual sickness.

The recent COP 21 agenda (conference of parties) under UNFCCC to keep the global temperature just below 2°C (from pre-industrial level) is a step to appreciate the importance of good environmental health before actual global vulnerability (sickness) of sea level rise, climate change and global warming.

Recently Indian government has undertaken largest financial inclusion programme and mission Indradhanush (to revamp public sector bank); a healthy financial measure before any financial crisis (sickness)

It is the valuation of sound technical health to fight global challenges in future, that we have cutting edge innovation for space exploration, resource management, biotechnology etc. before existence of actual crisis.

Though, Visualising speculations of probable causes of sickness and remedial measures to combat such challenges

is resource exhausting and is in hands of few hands but it promotes a

good healthy ecosystem to live in for longer time.

It is evident that precautionary measures
to avoid sickness and appreciating good health
can have multiplier effect.

measures to measure how sickness comes:-

To promote a good health it is vital that
various causes which impact good health
shall be recognised.

The high malnutrition rate among children,
high IMR (infant mortality rate) high MMR
(high Maternal mortality rate) etc among Indian
population is an evidence of demographic dividend
which is going to be a demographic disaster.

It will severely impact future health expenditure.
a less capable and "sick workforce" will create
less productive workforce which is bad for
"economic health."

Remarks

The rising NPAs (Non performing Assets) in Banks, Twin balance sheet problem (Corporate and banks) infrastructure bottleneck, "jobless growth" and declining job opportunities symbolises sick economic policies.

Similarly rising crime rate, globalisation of terrorism, increased cyber crime, increased tension among countries over geopolitical issues shows sickness of international cooperation to counter global challenges.

Remedial measures to promote good Health:

Based on consequences of sickness appropriate measures are required so as to promote not only physical, mental and psychological health, but also intellectual, economical, social, political and health.

It is based on the evidence of country, polity, economy and ~~policy~~ ^{society} going toward a sickness that several measures have been taken.

Mission Indradhanush (an umbrella immunisation and vaccination programme), Integrated child development programme and various government policies are undertaken to promote good

Remarks

health.

India has launched Swachh Bharat Mission (a cleanliness drive) to promote better hygiene (a precautionary measure before widespread health hazard).

In lack of appropriate resources it is acceptable to have inability to avoid sickness, but one should not wait to last moment for disaster to occur than taking precautionary measures.

We should learn from "past sickness" and its causes; take remedial steps in present; so as to enjoy a healthy life in future.

"Health is wealth" thus wealth must be utilised to appreciate the health before sickness.

While absence of opportunities render the preparedness as futile and useless, whereas the absence of appropriate competency, hard work, efficiency and effectiveness which can't lead to success when appropriate opportunities are available.
