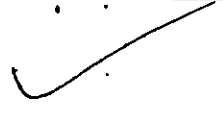

Mahatma Gandhi's Talisman, stands perfect enough to provide key to solve the visible mysteries of this world.

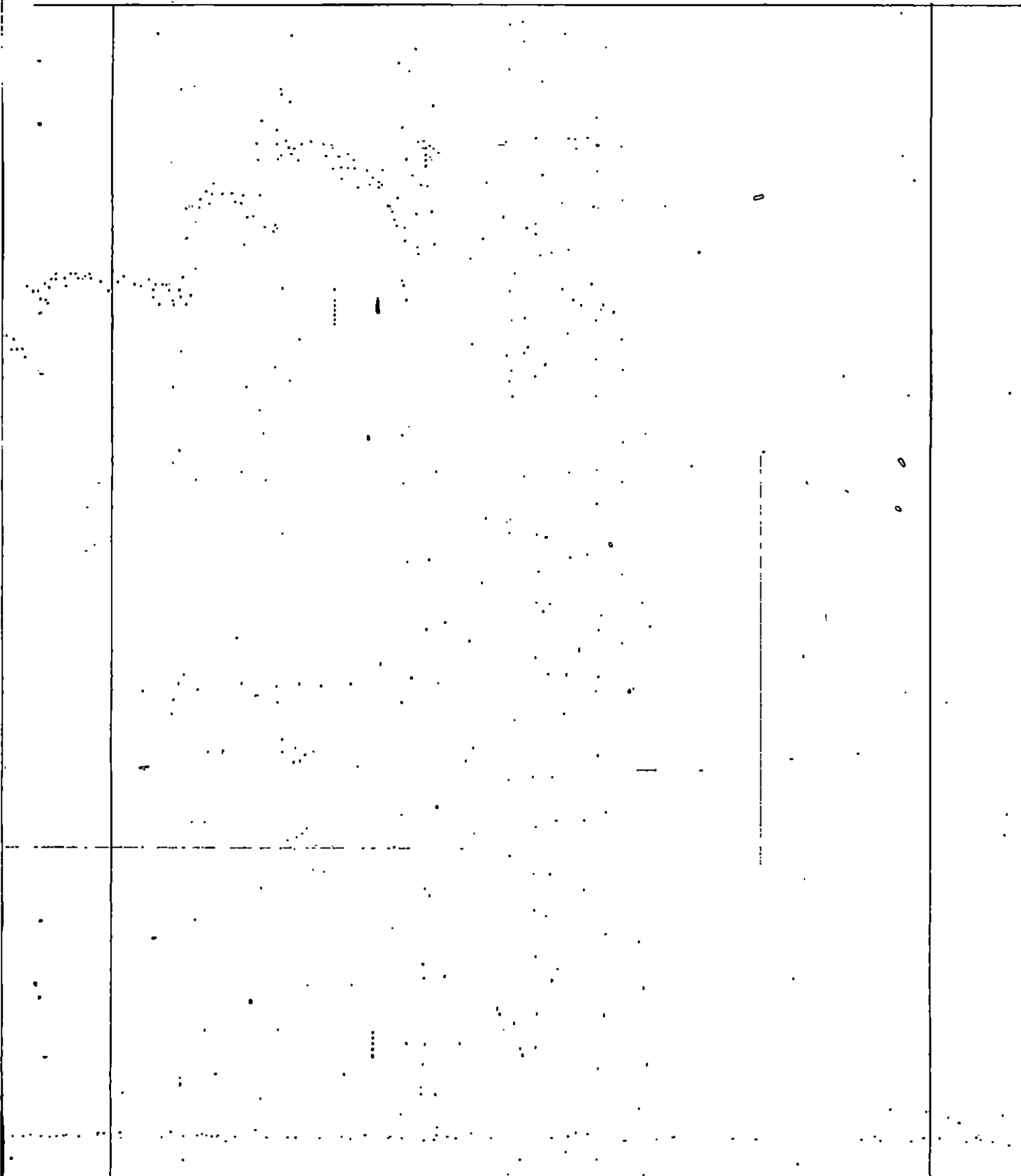
