can follow in case of such instances rather than to avoid it completely.

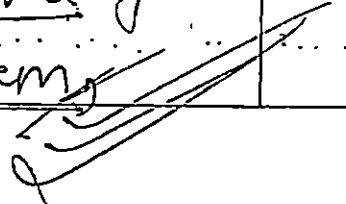
