A world where peace prevails can be achieved if human rights are ensured in every policy decision. It is up to the man to decide whether he wants to live a happy life or a life in greed and need.


Those enjoying power need to realise that it's not about your position, it is your conduct that makes you superior. Hence, one should always be a guiding light rather than a source of darkness.

However, consumerism brought with itself many evils like decline of institution of welfare state, joint families, It led to increase in inequality, skewed development, serious environmental concerns like climate change, The original culture ^{got} diminished and the dominant culture of consumerism prevailed. Consumerism has affected all aspects of a society. Wars have been fought for markets, resources. Countries which refused to fall in line faced economic sanctions and had to face issues of food shortages. It is often said that consumerism gave people no choice. 




