At the same time, it would be unfair to say that no positives are being generated out of it. In fact, it is anything but that.

For instance, TWITTER SEVA service allows people to convey their grievances to the government. And reports show, that it has created a sturdy Grievance Redressa Mechanism. Everyday problems, ranging from Lack of cleanliness in Trains + delay in passport matters were resolved using <sup>such</sup> social media services.

Similarly, Facebook Disaster service enables identification of family members and friends in a Disaster prone area. This

reduces Rumour Mongering and helps in better Planning of Disaster Management.

Likewise, social media is a source of quick news and information from a variety of sources. This breaks the Monopoly of existing News agencies and induces the benefit out of competition.

It can also be used as a platform for education, where students and teachers can together share resources and conduct live classes.

Similarly, anthropologists and Crime Investigators like Police (London) <sup>police</sup>

Agencies use Social Media Trends to derive more information that complements their existing work.

Finally, it is still being used for the encouraged task of connectivity. Old college friends use Facebook to connect to each other. Family members, especially Old Parents, ~~do~~ use it to engage in Video Conferencing with NRI children. Similarly, professionals use mediums like Whatsapp to share resources quickly. Even, District Administration is using these tools to ascertain ground level expenditures and to reduce leakages and corruption.

The only issue is that these benefits out of social media are being clouded by the ills generated by it.



Hence, to return to the original glory, it is necessary that required steps are taken.

At the individual level, we need to be careful on what we share. ~~Anything that~~ It is our duty to report, any inflammatory post, else legally we ourselves may be prosecuted. Also, we need to take use of Privacy filters provided by these websites, to guard our own privacy. At the same time, there is a need to advise & warn friends and relatives about right conduct & guard our own children.

The social media websites, ~~now~~ also need to take more responsibility and remove any anti-social content. Some

websites like Facebook are taking steps to identify post-truth stories. Others too need to follow up.

Finally, the government has a role to play. It must ramp up its own presence on social media to reduce rumours, identify crimes, redress grievances and deliver benefits. e-governance schemes should be complemented on the platform.

It also needs to take the support of civil society - (eg. Anonymous group on Twitter) and international partners to be more effective.

Thus, social media has a dual face. It creates and destroys at the same time. It joins & divides, at the same time.

And one but way to maximise its efficiency is to have a Balance in its use.
